Why Should Hospitals Be Concerned About Mycobacterium Tuberculosis?

The current approach for TB prevention has led to a case increase of TB in 20 states (2005);

- The Advisory Council for the Elimination of Tuberculosis (ACET) is alarmed (14,902 cases in 2005).*
- We need to protect our patient population against M-tb and other strains including DRS.*

Building the Business Case For Prevention of TB Disease in Healthcare Facilities

- Cost of Treating TB disease = \$25,000 - \$35,000/per case.*
- Cost of Treating multi-drug resistant TB = \$1.5 million/per case.*
- Between 2003-2004, data shows there was a 13% overall increase in multi-drug resistant TB (MDR-TB), and patients diagnosed with the extensively drug resistant strains known as (XDR) in the US and elsewhere were 64% more likely to die during treatment.*
- In a 2005 report, Guidelines for Preventing Transmission of Mycobacterium tuberculosis in a healthcare setting, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) specifies protocols that hospitals must perform fast to keep airborne infectious droplet nuclei (AIDN) from spreading to surrounding areas.*
- Portable Containment is a key component of environmental containment for airborne diseases in the OR setting and in other patient care areas.*
